to try out new, more adaptive behaviors and, in doing so, to better understand themselves and their recovery process. As survivors come to terms with their abuse histories and develop healthier behaviors and relationship patterns, they are able to test out some of those new patterns. The increased confidence, mastery and sense of responsibility that survivors build as a result of participating in ASCA meetings are skills that transfer to the larger world.

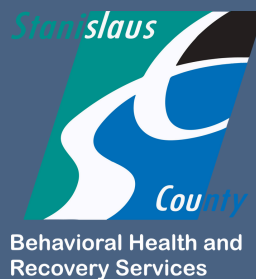
